Troop 97 is proud to sponsor a 2012 Trail to Eagle Course. This specialty course will provide an opportunity for Scouts to earn 5 merit badges over a 5 month period attending three sessions starting **Sunday, January 29, 2012**.

All aspects of this course will follow the Merit Badge process (no short cuts) and provides a structured environment for success. Each scout will contact their assigned MB counselor and they will have contact with him or her throughout the entire duration of this course.

Additional topics to assist the scout on his Trail to Eagle will be covered during the sessions: What is an Eagle Scout?, Planning the Trail to Eagle, What is a good Service Project?, How to plan a Service Project. There will also be additional activities for team building and outdoor challenges.

This course is offered to those Scouts who are 14 years of age or older, have at least attained the rank of Star and have attended Summer Camp in 2010 or 2011. A confirmation will be mailed to confirm acceptance and will include all of the necessary forms as well as additional information about the program.

The Merit Badges being offered are effort intensive and will include activities that occur at home in between sessions.
