Iditarod is a high adventure event held in tandem with Klondike. Patrols of scouts may test their winter camping skills by participating in Klondike events during the day. At 2:30 PM they begin the Iditarod trek to the Iditarod campsite by sledge with all of their overnight gear. Once at the campsite patrols are expected to follow the Iditarod activities outlined below.

Iditarod trek patrols must hike from A-Field at 2:30 PM Saturday, to the Iditarod campsite and then to pick up location on Sunday morning. All patrols members must be properly outfitted for winter camping, demonstrate teamwork, stow all gear neatly, display a patrol flag and show scout spirit.

Patrols must choose a campsite, set up their camp and on Sunday break the campsite down. Patrols must demonstrate their knowledge of winter camping skills, setup a campfire, cook their meals, leave no trace camping and show scout spirit.

Scoutmaster approval is required for all Iditarod Participants.
