Recommended Packing Strategy

- One rolling storage trunk or duffel
- One day pack/backpack
- One sleeping gear bag
- Use gallon-sized Ziplock bags to organize smaller items and keep clothing dry
- WRITE YOUR SCOUT'S NAME ON EVERYTHING

Essential Sleeping Gear

- Sleeping bag OR blanket + sheets
- Pillow
- Foam pad or inflatable mattress
- Sleeping clothes / pajamas
- Battery-operated lantern for tent
